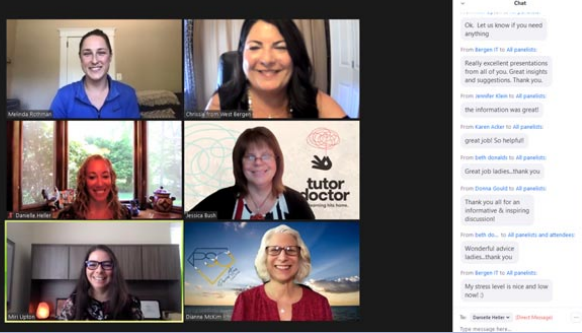


June's "Office 365 - Top Tools to Power Your Small Business" Lunch & Learn was presented by Stew Smith of Business Machine Technologies

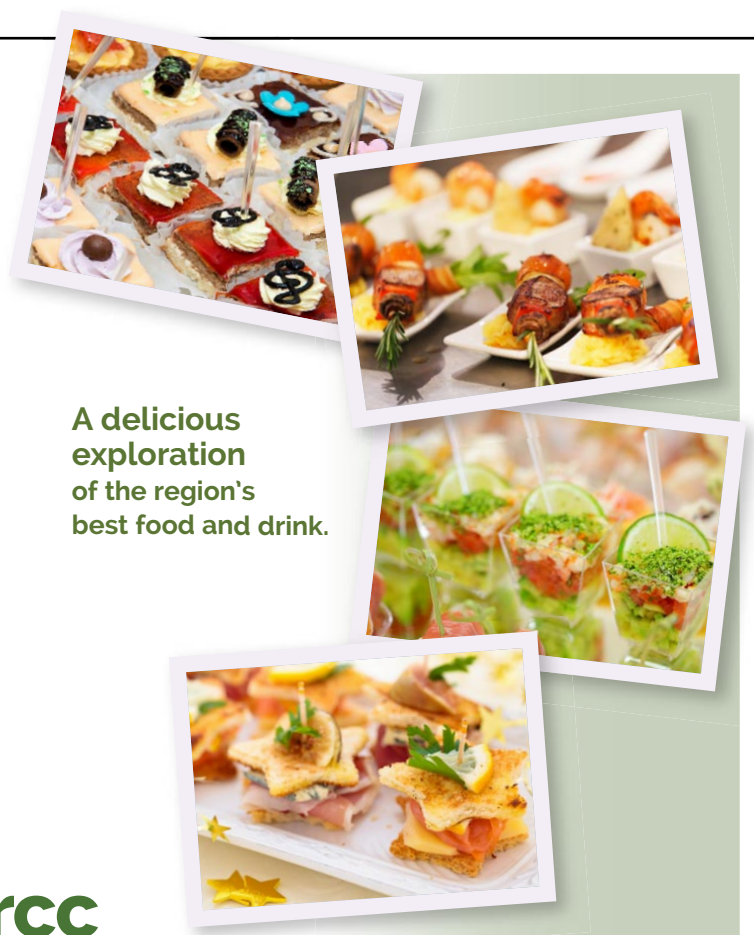
